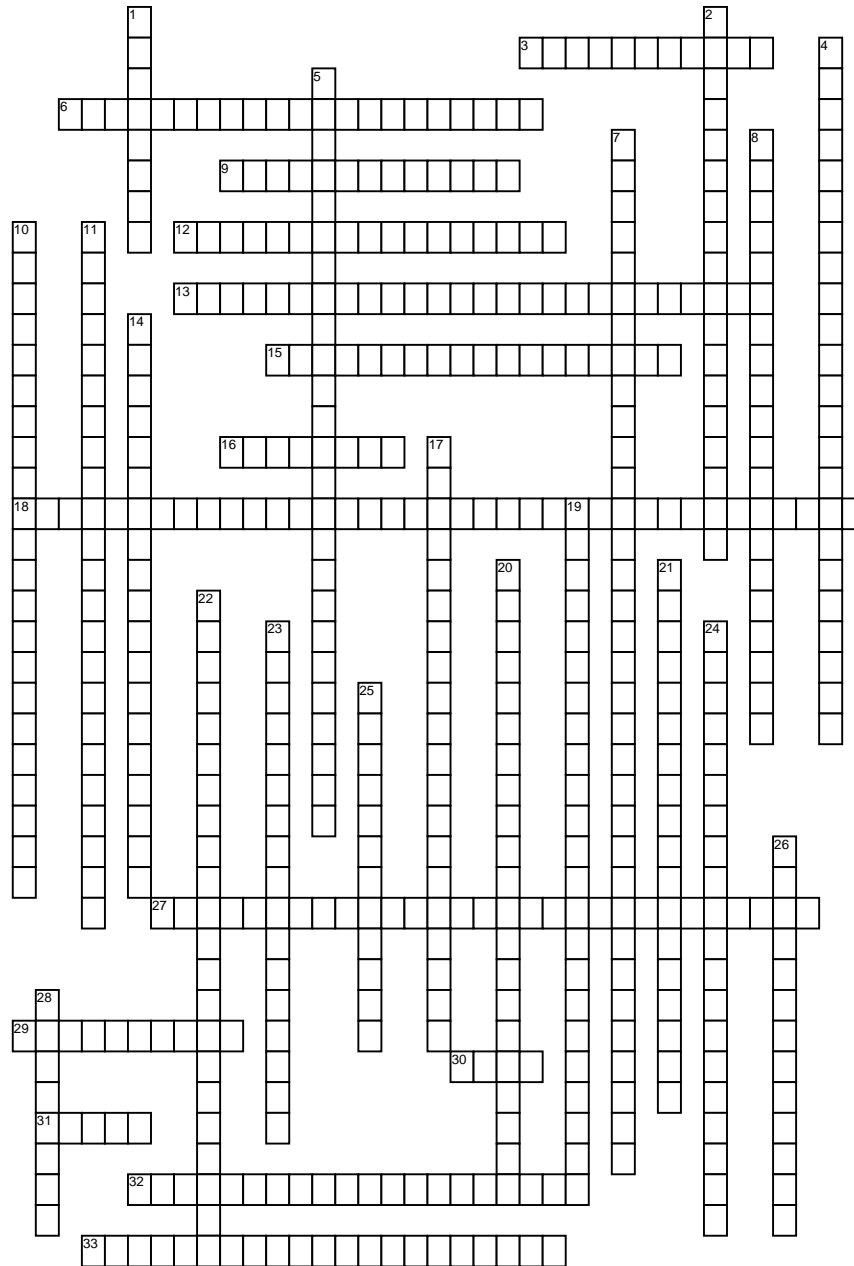

### ACROSS

- 3 second phase in relationship termination, when the individual discusses termination with the partner  
 6 ending of a relationship by one partner, even though the other partner wants it to continue  
 9 violations of understandings between people in relationships  
 12 theory that relational development occurs in conjunction with various tensions that exist in all relationships, particularly connectedness versus autonomy, predictability versus novelty, and openness versus closedness  
 13 interpersonal relationship that exists because of life circumstances  
 15 type of couple most satisfied in their relationships  
 16 message that a failure event has occurred  
 18 other-oriented skills based on the knowledge and understanding gained in a specific intimate relationship  
 27 attempts to break up a relationship without explicitly stating the desire to do so  
 29 subordinates' feeling more satisfied in their jobs the more their supervisors are able to influence higher-level decisions  
 30 a feeling of discontent arising from a desire for something someone else has  
 31 metaphor which demonstrates levels of self-disclosure  
 32 theory which states that people seek the greatest amount of reward with the least amount of cost  
 33 ignoring, laughing, or being silent in response to a hurtful message

- 1 repeated, unwelcome intrusions that create concern for personal safety and fear in the target  
 2 event that brings about a change in a relationship  
 4 communication among colleagues or coworkers at the same level within an organization

- 5 responding with violence to a specific relational conflict or tension  
 7 model of the relationships among family adaptability, cohesion, and communication  
 8 crying, conceding, or apologizing in response to a hurtful message  
 10 theory that suggests that all loving relationships can be described according to 3 dimensions: intimacy, commitment, and passion  
 11 relationship in which both partners behave toward power in the same way, either both wanting it or both avoiding it  
 14 intentionally holding back some of the information another person has requested or that you are expected to share  
 17 families with a low orientation toward both conversation and conformity  
 19 a strategy we use to increase others' liking of us  
 20 potential for a relationship to confirm our self-image compared to its potential costs  
 21 families with a high orientation toward both conversation and conformity  
 22 movement of a relationship away from intimacy through stages such as turmoil or stagnation, deintensification, individualization, etc.  
 23 using violence to control or dominate  
 24 relationship in which power shifts back and forth between the partners, depending on the situation  
 25 deception by commission involving outright falsification of information intended to deceive the listener  
 26 2 adults and their children; because of divorce, separation, death or adoption, children are the offspring of other biological parents or of just one of the adults who are raising them  
 28 reaction to the threat of losing a valued relationship
